

UP ALUMNI ENGINEERS (UPAE) AWARDS

GENERAL CRITERIA / REQUIREMENTS:

In all the categories, the following shall be considered:

- All statements of outstanding achievements must have supporting documents.
- Nominee must be of proven moral Integrity.
- Nominee should not be a current UPAE Board Member.
- Nominee must have maintained linkages with the Department, College, University and/or the country

TYPES OF AWARDS:

A. Most Distinguished Alumnus / Alumna Award

The nominee must have attained national and possibly international stature and has brought honor and prestige to the College of Engineering, the University and/or the Country.

He/She must be outstanding not only in his/her chosen engineering field/s but also in other areas of endeavor related to his/her profession.

B. Professional Degree Awards

The award is

given to outstanding alumni who have excelled in their respective degree programs.

- Chemical Engineering
- Civil Engineering
- Computer Engineering
- Computer Science
- Electrical Engineering
- Electronics and Communications Engineering
- Geodetic Engineering
- Industrial Engineering
- Materials Engineering

- Metallurgical Engineering
- Mining Engineering
- Mechanical Engineering

The nominee must have attained national and international recognition in the particular field for which he/she has been nominated.

The more recent achievements, particularly within the past decade, or very outstanding recent achievements will be given priority over achievements long past.

C. **Achievement Awards**:

1. National

- Lifetime
- Engineering Education
- Government Service
- Public Service
- Entrepreneurship
- 2. **Global** For his/her international and/or regional achievement, as evidenced by a certification/s from reputableinstitutions. Several alumni may be given this award.

These awards are

given to alumni who have made outstanding accomplishments in areas of endeavor related to the Engineering field and thereby contributing to the development and improvement of the profession.

Specific categories may vary each year depending on the development and improvement of the profession; the nominations received; and the nominees' achievements.

D. Presidents Award

This award is given to the immediate past President of the UPAE for his leadership and contribution to the Association.

E. Posthumous Award

This award is given to accomplished alumni who have passed away recently but have not been recognized by the UPAE during his lifetime.

THE NOMINATION PROCESS

Nominations for the different awards are accepted from any U.P. Engineering alumnus or alumni chapter/organizations.

In addition to the nominations submitted by individual alumni and UPAE chapters/organizations, the UPAE may establish search committees to intensify the search for awardees.

INSTRUCTIONS AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR NOMINATORS

- 1. Nominations for different categories shall be made by accomplishing and submitting corresponding nomination forms.
- 2. Nomination forms should be accompanied with documentation in support of the statement of achievements, such as copies of diplomas, certificates, citations, news articles, photographs, etc., and nominee's recent photo.
- 3. The nominator should prepare a statement on the work, achievements, accomplishments or performance of the chapter or group, all of which forms the basis and justification for the nomination. Supporting documents such as copies of citations/awards, news clippings, photographs and other materials may be submitted.
- 4. The UPAE prefers that, besides submitting the nomination forms and supporting documents in paper copies, nominators also prepare and send an electronic or digital version of these materials, i.e., in the form of an email attachment. In any case, all these must be delivered or mailed to:

- 5. Nominations should be received by the UPEA not later than TUESDAY, 15 SEPTEMBER, or postmarked not later than the above date. Only complete and properly accomplished forms shall be accepted.
- 6. The UPAE Search and Awards Committee will deliberate on the nominations and may request additional information or documents from the nominators. The Committee's decisions are final and are submitted to the UPAE Board for affirmation.
- 7. The UPAE will immediately notify the awardee of her/his selection for the award. In the event that the awardee declines to accept the award and/or fails to attend the awarding ceremonies, the UPAE reserves the right to withdraw the award.
- 8. Awards may not be given in all categories every year. Sometimes there are no nominees in a certain category, or the nominees may not meet the standards for granting the award.
- 9. All Alumni Awardees, except the Global awardees and the family representative of the Posthumous awardee must attend the awarding ceremonies during the General Alumni Homecoming to personally receive their award.
