



UP ALUMNI ENGINEERS (UPAE) AWARDS

GENERAL CRITERIA / REQUIREMENTS:

In all the categories, the following shall be considered:

- All statements of outstanding achievements must have supporting documents.
- Nominee must be an outstanding member of the UP Alumni Engineers.
- Nominee must be of proven moral Integrity.
- Nominee is available to receive the award during the UPAE November Homecoming.
 - (This may be waived for the Global Engineer Award.)
- Nominee should not be a current UPAE Board Member.
- Nominee must have maintained linkages with the Department, College, University and/or the country.

TYPES OF AWARDS:

A. Most Distinguished Alumnus / Alumna Award

The nominee must have attained national and possibly international stature and has brought honor and prestige to the College of Engineering, the University and/or the Country. He/She must be outstanding not only in his/her chosen engineering field/s but also in other areas of endeavor related to his/her profession.

Nominees must not be a recipient of the Top 100 Alumni Engineers of the Century (the highest award that was given by the UPAE), any alumni who were already given this award will be automatically over qualified to any of the award and must not be elected anymore.

B. Lifetime Achievement Award

The nominees must be senior alumni who have achieved professional distinction and demonstrated meritorious service throughout their career.

Nominees should also be a recipient of any other award given by the UPAE e.g. Professional Degree, National or Global Award. Given the character of this award, alumni who have retired from service in the public or private sector (but may still be active) may merit higher rating points for the award

C. Professional Degree Awards

The award is given to outstanding alumni who have excelled in their respective degree programs.

- a. Chemical Engineering
- b. Civil Engineering
- c. Computer Engineering

- d. Computer Science
- e. Electrical Engineering
- f. Electronics and Computer Engineering
- g. Geodetic Engineering
- h. Industrial Engineering
- i. Materials Engineering
- j. Metallurgical Engineering
- k. Mining Engineering
- l. Mechanical Engineering

The nominee must have attained national and international recognition in the particular field for which he/she has been nominated. The more recent achievements, particularly within the past decade, or a very outstanding recent achievement will be given priority over achievements long past.

D. Achievement Awards:

a. National

- Engineering Education
- Government Service
- Public Service
- Entrepreneurship

Nominees must show proof of his/her regional achievement, as evidence by a certification/s from reputable institutions.

These awards are given to alumni who have made outstanding accomplishments in areas of endeavor related to the Engineering field and thereby contributing to the development and improvement of the profession.

b. Global

Nominees must show proof of his/her international achievement, as evidence by a certification/s from reputable institutions. Specific categories may vary each year depending on the development and improvement of the profession; the nominations received; and the nominees' achievements.

These awards are given to alumni who have made outstanding accomplishments in areas of endeavor related to the Engineering field and thereby contributing to the development and improvement of the profession.

E. Citation of Merit

This award shall be given to deserving alumni, UP COE Instructor who, within 10 years of their graduation, has achieved significant accomplishments in:

- Technopreneuership
- Research and Development

F. Posthumous Award

This award is given to accomplished alumni who have passed away recently but have not been recognized by the UP AE during his lifetime.

G. UPAE President's Award

This award is given to the immediate past President of the UPAE for his leadership and contribution to the Association.
